

Boston Scott The State of Alabama This Indenture made and entered  
To Shelby County 3 into this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of June 1878,  
W M Kidd between Scott Boston debtor of the first part and  
J M Kidd creditor of the 2nd part witnesseth That  
wheresoever the said party of the first part is justly in-  
debted to the party of the 2nd part in the sum of  
Forty dollars, due by Pro or missory Notes and paya-  
ble on or before the 1st day of Novr 1878; and the said  
party of the 1st part being desirous to secure the  
payment of said indebtedness; for and in consideration  
thereof, the said party of the 1st part has sold, and  
hereby sells and conveys to the said party of the 2nd  
part, the following described property, to wit:  
All the corn and cotton grown in the year 1878,  
to have and to hold, in trust, as follows: It is hereby  
agreed that the said party of the 1st part is to have  
and retain possession of the said property until the  
1st day of Nov 1878, and if the said party of the 1st  
part shall fully pay to the said party of the 2nd part  
said debt and interest thereon, and reasonable ex-  
penses hereof by said 1st day of Nov 1878, then this  
indenture is to be null and void. But upon de-  
fault of such payment the said party of the 2nd  
part is hereby authorized to take into possession,  
and sell said property to the highest bidder for cash,  
at such time and place as he may select after giving  
ten days notice of the time and place of said  
sale by publication in a newspaper, if one is publish-  
ed in the County, or by posting at three public  
places, and out of the proceeds of said sale retain  
the sum of Forty dollars, and interest thereon,  
and the reasonable costs hereof, and the balance

if any, pay to the said party of the 1<sup>st</sup> part. And it  
is agreed the party of the 2<sup>nd</sup> part may purchase  
at said sale.
