

Deshazo R.M. The State of Alabama } This indenture made and
 Jno. T. Heflin } entered into this 22nd day of
 July A.D. 1878. between Rufus M. Deshazo as
 Sheriff of the County of Shelby in the State of
 Alabama, of the one part, and Jno. T. Heflin of
 the County of Talladega, in the State aforesaid, of the
 other part, witnesseth, that whereas on the 1st day
 of April 1878, judgment was duly rendered
 in the Circuit-Court for the County of Shelby, in
 the State aforesaid, at the Spring Term 1878, of the
 said Circuit-Court, for the sum of One hundred
 and two dollars besides costs, in favor of John
 T. Heflin, and against William St. Lacy, on which
 said judgment - there was issued by the Clerk of
 the Circuit-Court, for said County, on the 15th day
 of June 1878, a certain writ of "Fieri facias" in
 favor of said John T. Heflin and against the said
 William St. Lacy directed to any Sheriff of the
 State of Alabama, whereby such Sheriff was directed
 to levy of the estate of said William St. Lacy the
 sum of two hundred & two dollars besides eight-
 & 9/100 dollars costs, and which said writ - was
 on the 15th day of June 1878, placed in the hands
 of the said Rufus M. Deshazo as Sheriff of said
 County of Shelby, for the purpose of its levy and
 execution; and whereas, said Rufus M. Deshazo as
 Sheriff as aforesaid, after the said writ had come
 into his hands, and while the same was in full
 force, did on the 19th day of June 1878 levy the same
 on the following tracts of land as the property of
 the said defendant William St. Lacy viz the N 1/2
 of the N E 1/4 Section 4 T 21 Range 3 west, and all of the S 1/2 of
 the N E 1/4 Section 4 T 21 Range 3 west that lies East of the
 Meredith Spring branch, The W 1/2 of the South west 1/4
 Section 34 T 20 R 3 west and all of that part of the S E 1/4
 of the S E 1/4 Sect-33 T 20 Range 3 west that lies East of
 Beaver dam Creek and South of the branch known
 as the line between Mrs D. C. Wyatt and William St. Lacy
 lying and being in the County of Shelby; and whereas, the said
 Rufus M. Deshazo as Sheriff as aforesaid, after having duly ad-
 vertised the said tracts of land for sale in the mode pre-
 scribed by law, did in accordance with said advertisement

on the 22^d day of July 1878, in the town of Montevallo proceed to sell the same, under and by virtue of said writ of "fieri facias", and the said John T. Hepler having bid for said lands, then and there selling as aforesaid, the sum of Fifty dollars, and it being the highest and best bid that could then and there be got for the same, he the said Sheriff did therefore sell and cry off the said tracts of land to the said John T. Hepler. Now therefore, in consideration of the premises, the said party of the first-part, as Sheriff of said County of Shelby, has and does hereby bargain and sell, alien and convey unto the said John T. Hepler the said tracts of land to-wit: The N¹/₂ of the N^E/₄ Section 4 T 21 R 3 West and all that part of the South ¹/₂ of the N^E/₄ Section 4 T 21 Range 3 West that lies East of the Meredith Spring branch and the N¹/₂ of the S^W/₄ Section 34 T 20 Range 3 West and all that part of the S^E/₄ of the S^E/₄ Section 33 T 20 R 3 West that lies East of Beaver dam creek and South of the Branch known as the line between Mrs D C Myatt and William N Lacy. to have and to hold the aforesaid lands, together with all and singular its appertinances thereunto, belonging to the said John T. Hepler and to his heirs and assigns forever; and the said party of the first-part; as Sheriff as aforesaid, does covenant with the said parties of the second part, that he as Sheriff as aforesaid, will warrant the title to the said lands, so far only as he by virtue of his said office is authorized to do, but it is expressly understood, that said Rufus M. Deshazo is in no event to be individually liable for any thing herein contracted, In testimony whereof, the said party of the first-part, has signed, and delivered this deed on the day it bears date,
