I, P. J. Henderson, do hereby promise  
On or before the first day of November next to promise  
for R. B. Page to pay to the order of J. H. Page the sum of Twenty five  
Dollars, at his store in said County for value received in  
necessary provisions, and money to purchase the same, ad-  
vanced by him to me for the purpose of enabling me to  
make a crop, for the current year. This advance was ob-  
tained "bono fide" for the purpose of enabling me to  
make a crop, and without such advance it would  
not have been in the power of said F. G. Archer to  
procure the necessary teams, provisions, and farming  
implements to make a crop the present year. In con-  
sideration of which I hereby grant to said J. H. Page  
a due on my crop grown on my plantation in Shelby  
County, Alabama, and waive the right of exemption  
under the laws of Alabama, as provided for in section  
4 Article 10 in the Constitution of the State of Alabama.
