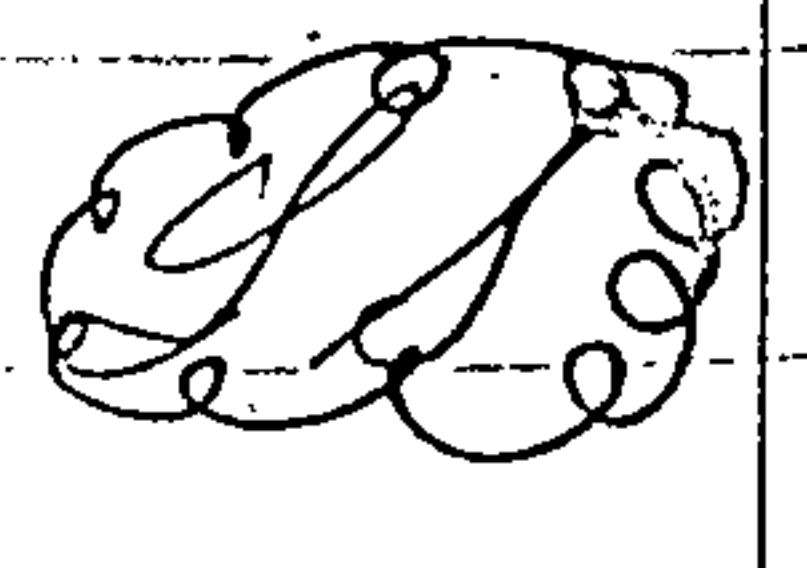


Farley J. M. The State of Alabama, Know all men by these presents, That
 To Shelby County } for and in consideration of my in-
 A. B. Waldrop) debtedness to A. B. Waldrop in the sum of Seventy nine
 32/100 (\$79.32) Dollars due by note bearing date Nov 26
 1878 and payable November 1st 1879, now to secure the punctu-
 al payment of said indebtedness, I do hereby sell and con-
 vey to say A. B. Waldrop the following goods and chattles,
 to wit; my entire crop to be grown the year 1879, One
 Bull faced sorrel Mare 7 years old, one Bull faced
 sorrel Colt 2 years old, One yoke red Oxen 4 years old
 marked Swallow fork ^{under bit} in the left & overslope in right,
 Two Mule cows 4 & 4 years old marked Swallow fork &
 under bit in left & overslope in the right, warranted free
 from incumbrance and against any adverse claims, upon
 condition however, that if I pay said debt to said A. B.
 Waldrop or his assigns, with interest, this deed to be
 void; but if I fail to pay said debt in whole or in part
 at maturity, then said A. B. Waldrop his agents or
 assigns are authorized to take possession of said prop-
 erty, and after giving 10 days notice by ~~publication~~
 publishing, to sell the same at Bold Springs Church to
 the highest bidder, for cash, and the proceeds to devote to
 the paying, 1st, The expenses of Advertising and
 selling, and 2nd, The amount with interest, that
 may be due on said note and the surplus, if any
 to be turned over to the undersigned.
