

Lyon J N \$8.60 Pages Store Ala Feby 4th 1879

To On the first day of November 1879 I promise to pay to the order
 Jas H Page of J H Page the sum of eighteen and 60/100 Dollars at his store for
 value received, in necessary provisions, and money to purchase the
 same, advanced by him to me for the purpose of enabling me to
 make a crop for the current year. This advance was
 obtained "bonafide" for the purpose of enabling me to make
 a crop, and without such advances it would not have been
 in the power of said J N Lyon to procure the necessary teams
 provisions and farming implements to make a crop the present
 year. In consideration of which I hereby grant to said J H
 Page a lien on my crop grown on my plantation or lands
 rented, and waive the right of exemption under the laws
 of Alabama, as provided for in Section 4 Article 10 in the
 Constitution of the State of Alabama.
