

Lyon J. H. (1860) Pages Store Ala Feby 4<sup>o</sup> 1879  
 To  
 On the first day of November 1879 I promise to pay to the order  
 of J. H. Page the sum of eighteen and 67/100 Dollars at his store or  
 value received, in necessary provisions, and money to purchase the  
 same advanced by him to me for the purpose of enabling me to  
 make a crop for the current year. This advance was  
 obtained "bona fide" for the purpose of enabling me to make  
 a crop, and without such advances it would not have been  
 in the power of said J. H. Lyon to procure the necessary teams  
 provisions and farming implements to make a crop the present  
 year. In consideration of which I hereby grant to said J. H.  
 Page a lien on my crop grown on my plantation or lands  
 rented, and waive the right of exemption under the laws  
 of Alabama, as provided for in Section 7 Article 10 in the  
 Constitution of the State of Alabama.
