

Partridge J. A. #25-00 Wilsonville Ala January 30th 1879

To
On the 15th day of November after date I promise to pay to
J. E. Deuster & Co the Order of J. E. Deuster & Co Twenty five Dollars at Wilsonville
Ala. value received in necessary provisions and money to
purchase the same advanced by J. E. Deuster & Co to me for
the purpose of enabling me to make a crop for the
current year. This advance was obtained here before for the
purpose of enabling me to make a crop and without such
advances it would not have been in the power of said
J. A. Partridge to procure the necessary teams provisions
and farming implements to make a crop the present year,
In consideration of which I hereby grant to said J. E. Deuster
& Co a lien on my crop grown on Mrs. M. C. Black's
plantation and waive the right of exemption under the
laws of Alabama as provided for in Section 7 Article 10
in the Constitution of the State of Alabama,
