

Wallace Andrew, \$75.00 Wilsonville Ala Feby 11th 1879

To On the 1st of November after date I promise to pay to the
J. E. Deuster & Co order of J. E. Deuster & Co seventy five dollars at Wilsonville
Ala, value received in necessary provisions and money to
purchase the same advanced by J. E. Deuster & Co to me for
the purpose of enabling me to make a crop for the current
year. This advance was obtained "bona fide" for the purpose
of enabling me to make a crop and without such
advances it would not have been in the power of
said Andrew Wallace to procure the necessary teams pro-
visions and farming implements to make a crop the
present year. In consideration of which I hereby grant
to said J. E. Deuster & Co a lien on my crop grown on W. W.
Wallace's plantation and waive the right of exemption
under the laws of Alabama as provided for in Section 7
Article 10 in the Constitution of the State of Alabama.
