

Bishop J. B. \$50.00 Wilsonville Ala Jan'y 26 1879

To On November 1st after date I promise to pay to J. B. Deesler & Co the order of J. B. Deesler & Co Fifty (50) Dollars at Wilsonville Alabama value received in necessary provisions and money to purchase the same advanced by J. B. Deesler & Co to me for the purpose of enabling me to make a crop for the current year. This advance was obtained "bona fide" for the purpose of enabling me to make a crop, and without such advance it would not have been in the power of said J. B. Bishop to procure the necessary teams provisions and farming implements to make a crop the present year. In consideration of which I hereby grant to said J. B. Deesler & Co a lien on my crop grown on John Logan's plantation, and waive the right of exemption under the laws of Alabama as provided for in Section 7 Article 10 in the Constitution of the State of Alabama
