premises to the said William Merrill his heirs and assigns to
their use and behoof forever and we do Covenant with the
said William Merrill his heirs and assigns that we are law-
fully seized in fee of the aforesaid premises that they are free
of all incumbrance that we have a good right to sell and Con-
vey the said land to said William Merrill his heirs and assigns
and that we will warrant and defend the said premises to the
said William Merrill his heirs and assigns forever against the
lawful claims and demands of all persons. In witness whereof
we the said heirs and joint heirs have hereunto set our hands
and seals this the 2^d day of December in the year of our Lord
One thousand eight hundred and sixty nine
