 entire One hundred and fifty six  $\frac{1}{100}$  one thousandth part undi-  
 vided interest in the five hundred and forty (540) acres of coal land  
 as specified in exhibit "D" attached to the Contract and Indenture  
 of this date of the heirs of the Stovs estate for the distribution of said  
 estate among themselves - Witness my hand and seal this sixteenth  
 day of July A.D Eighteen hundred and eighty
