 and State aforesaid Witnesseth that for and in Consideration of  
 the sum of Five hundred dollars to them in hand paid by  
 the party of the first part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowl-  
 edged the party of the first part does sell Convey and deliver  
 in fee simple the following lands to wit. The S E  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the  
 S M  $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 7 and the North half of the N M  $\frac{1}{4}$  and the S M  $\frac{1}{4}$   
 of the N M  $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 18 Township 19 Range 1 west and the  
 S  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the S M  $\frac{1}{4}$  & the S M  $\frac{1}{4}$  of S E  $\frac{1}{4}$  and all that part of the  
 N  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the S M  $\frac{1}{4}$  and N E  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the N E  $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 13 Township  
 19 Range 2 west that lies East of the Oak Ridge making  
 the fence of the said W.C. Gilbert the line so far as said fence  
 extends along the top of the Mountain or Ridge and then  
 the top of the Ridge shall be the established line through  
 said lands - Conveying to the said W.C. Gilbert all my  
 entire interest in said tract of land east of said Ridge  
 And the party of the first part will forever warrant and de-  
 fend the title to the same to the said W.C. Gilbert from all
