of Alabama, have this day for and in consideration of the sum of
Twenty-five hundred Dollars, to us in bank paid by Robert
L. McCalley, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, granted,
bargained, sold, and conveyed, and do by these presents grant
bargain, sell, and convey, and forever warrant and defend unto
the said Robert L. McCalley his heirs and assigns, in fee sim-
ple the following described tracts and parcels of land, lying
in the counties of Shelby and Chilton State of Alabama, name-
ly; The South half of Southwest quarter of sec. nine, and a
strip of land in the North west quarter of the South west quarter
of said Sec. nine. (9) lying South of the Centreville and Montevallo
dirt road; and the South East quarter of the South East quarter of
section Eight (8) and a strip of land off of the South side of the
North East quarter of the South East quarter of said section eight
lying South of the Centreville and Montevallo dirt road; and
all that tract of land in the West half of the South East quarter
of said section (8) Eight between the Centreville + Montevallo
dirt road and the West boundary line of the East half of the
South East quarter of said section; all of the above lands being
in Shelby County, State of Alabama. Also all of the North half
of the North west quarter of section (6) Sixteen, in Chiltons Coun-
ty Alabama, lying East of the Montevallo and Nabors Land dirt
road, as the Selma Road leading from Montevallo to Selma, which,
together with all of the above named lands are in Township (24).

Twenty-four, Range (12) twelve East, and are more fully described by the following metes and bounds, to wit: - Beginning on Section line at the South East corner of the South west quarter of section (9) in Township (24) north, range (12) twelve East; Running thence North on quarter section line (20) twenty chains; thence west parallel with section line (20) twenty chains to a stake in the Centerville and Montevallo dirt road; thence North $86\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ west along the middle of said Centerville and Montevallo dirt road, ($39\frac{3}{10}$ chs) thirty-nine chains & 33 links to where said dirt road crosses the East Tennessee, Virginia and Georgia Rail Road; - thence South 50° west along the middle of said Centerville and Montevallo dirt road, (25 chs) twenty-five chains, to a stake at the mouth of a ditch; - thence South 73° East along said ditch ($12\frac{1}{2}$ chs) to a stake on the section line between sections 8 & 17; - thence East on said section line ($4\frac{3}{4}$ chs) to a stake in the middle of the road leading from Montevallo to Selma by way of Randolph or Montevallo & Mahans Ford dirt road; - thence South west along the middle of the said Montevallo Mahans Ford dirt road to a stake at the South boundary line of the North half of the North west quarter of Sec. (16) sixteen, said stake being (2) two chains East of the South west corner of the North west quarter of the North west quarter of said sec. (16) sixteen; - thence East on the South boundary line of the North half of the North west quarter of Sec. 16. (38 chs) thirty-eight chains to the South East corner of the North East quarter of the North west quarter of said Sec. (16) sixteen; - thence North on quarter section line (20 chs) twenty chains to place of beginning. Containing in all _____ acres more or less.
