the State and County and County aforesaid. Wit-
nesseth; that in consideration that the party of the
second part, has by his deed of conveyance, of even
date with this Indenture, and for consideration there-
in set forth, has granted bargained, sold and con-
veyed, to the said Anna A. Lapsley, her heirs and
assigns, the following designated Tract or parcel of
land; that is to say: the west half of the South East
quarter, of section fourteen (4) in township twenty two
(22) and range (2) two west; situated in the State and
and County aforesaid; the parties of the first part have
bargained and sold, and conveyed and quit claim
and hereby bargain, sell and convey, and forever quit
claim, to said party of the second part, his heirs and
assigns of all their right, title, and interest, whatso-
ever the same may be, including all dower rights of
the said Anna A. Lapsley, in and to all and singular
the tracts or parcels of land situate in the State and
and County aforesaid, as designated and set forth in
the Schedule of lands, hereto annexed as a part of this
Indenture; which Schedule, marked Exhibit A. is
subscribed by the said John N. & Anna A. Lapsley; the
only interest therein claimed by the said Anna A.
Lapsley, in and to the lands specified in said

schedule, or any part thereof, being a dower right for the relinquishment whereof to the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, so far as she may possess such right of dower in and to said schedules lands or any part thereof, joins in this indenture. It is a consideration of this Indenture, that nothing herein contained shall have the effect to impair any right in and to the said schedule lands, or any part thereof, which may have been vested in the corporation heretofore existing under the name of Shelley Lime Company, their heirs and assigns, other than the said John N.
