

United States of America: To all to whom these  
presents shall come, greeting: Whereas, Davis Lee of Shelby  
County, Alabama, has deposited in the General Land  
Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of  
the land office, at Tuscaloosa, whereby it appears that  
full payment has been made by Davis Lee according  
to the provisions of the Act of Congress, of the 24<sup>th</sup> of April  
1820, entitled an "Act making further provision for the  
sale of the public lands", for the South half of the North  
East quarter, and the East half of the South West quarter  
of Section twenty eight, in township eighteen, of Range  
one west, in the District of Lands subject to sale at  
Tuscaloosa, Alabama, containing One hundred & fifty  
nine acres, and fourteen hundredth of an acre.  
according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said  
land, returned to the General Land Office, by the  
Surveyor General, which several tracts have been

purchase'd by said James Lee. Now know ye, that the United State of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case, made and provided, Have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said James Lee, and to his heirs the said tract above described; To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges immunities and appurtenances, of what ever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said James Lee and to his heirs and assigns forever. In testimony whereof I, James Buchanan, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed; Given under my hand at the City of Washington, the first day of June in the year of Our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and fifty eight, and of the Independence of the United States the eighty second.
