 of the first, for and his consideration of the sum of One  
 thousand & forty dollars to them in hand paid by the  
 said Martha A. Nolen. the receipt whereof is hereby ac-  
 knowledged, have bargained & sold & by these presents  
 do grant bargain, sell & convey unto the said Martha A.  
 A. Nolen, the following lands: lying and being in said  
 county and State to wit the NE<sup>1/4</sup> of the SW<sup>1/4</sup> & the  
 NW<sup>1/4</sup> of the SE<sup>1/4</sup> & the S<sup>r</sup> of the SW<sup>1/4</sup> of the NW<sup>1/4</sup> & the  
 W<sup>r</sup> of the NE<sup>1/4</sup> of the SE<sup>1/4</sup> all in Rec(17) section  
 Township 24 of Range twelve East, & in Shelley County  
 Ala containing in all one hundred & twenty acres  
 more or less to have and to hold unto the said Martha  
 A. Nolen her heirs and assigns forever and the said  
 parties of the first party covenant & agree with the said  
 Martha A. Nolen, her heirs and assigns, that they  
 are seized in their demesne as of fee to & in said  
 land, & they will warrant & forever defend, the same  
 free from incumbrances unto the said Martha A. Nolen  
 her heirs and assigns.
