is hereby acknowledged, I do grant, bargain, sell and  
convey to said Matilda L. Ballen the following de-  
scribed real estate to wit: The north west quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ )  
of the North West quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and north half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the  
North East quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the North West quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and  
ten (10) acres in the north west corner of the North East  
quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of section three (3) Township Twenty two (22)  
Range two (2) west. To have and to hold to the said  
Matilda L. Ballen her heirs and assigns forever.
