that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration
of the sum of six hundred & fifty Dollars, to him in
hand paid by the said Mary Jane Mitchell the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged has sold and hereby
sets convey and confesses unto the said Mary Jane
Mitchell the following described lot in the town of
Columbiaville County of Shelby State of Alabama,
known and denoted as follows. To wit - beginning at the
North East corner of section 26 township 21 & Range one
with them run along the section line, between, sections
23 & 26, to the public road running North from the Court House
there south along said road, to a stake about half way
between said section line, and S. V. Nobbs lot there.
East parallel with the road bound by line N and S and S. V.
Nobbs, lot to the section line between, sections 25 & 26
of said township, thence North along said section line
to the beginning, containing about six acres, more or less.
This lot of land his between, Doel Morel's lot on the North
and a lot sold by G. C. Street & wife & S. B. Rose to Street &
Ferguson, & Dallas County on the South. To have and
to hold to the said Mary Jane Mitchell her husband and
assigns forever. and the said William Allen hereby con-
nents, with the said Mary Jane Mitchell that he is
lawfully seized of and has a good right to sell and con-
vey said lands and hereby binds himself forever to
warrant and defend the title to said lands against
the claims of all and every person in law and equity
