The United States of America.
To all to whom these Presents shall come Issuings,
Whereas Susan Glass of Shelby County, Alabama has
deposited in the General Land Office of the United States
a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Mont-
gomery, Alabama, whereby it appears that full
payment has been made by the said Susan Glass
according to the provision of the act of Congress of the
24th of April 1820 entitled An Act making further
provisions for the sale of the Public Lands and the
Act Supplemental thereto for the north west

grants & the North West quarter of Section six, in township eighteen, South, & range one west of Huntsville Meridian in Alabama, containing forty acres and eleven hundredths of an acre: according to the official Plat of the Survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Susan Glan. Now know ye, that the United States of America in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such cases made and provided have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Susan Glan and to her heirs, the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of inhabitation nature, therunto belonging unto the said Susan Glan and to her heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof I, Chester A. Arthur, President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand at the City of Washington the twentieth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty four, and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and eighteen.
