paid to me in the year eighteen hundred & fifty  
nine by Shelley Linn Company bargained sold  
& conveyed all the right title & interest I hold in

the timber above eight or nine inches in diameter  
situate on the following described lands South West  
quarter of South West-quarter sec no. 16 T. 22 Range 2  
West containing  $40 \frac{3}{100}$  acres and the South East-quarter  
of the South East-quarter sec no. 4 T. 22 Range  
2 West containing  $40 \frac{3}{100}$  acres entered by said Williams  
in Tazewell in the year 1855. This sale as stated  
above was made in 1859. but the contracts were not drawn  
until date. It is also agreed that the said Williams  
have for his personal use any trees for boards or other  
mechanical purposes off <sup>any</sup> of said land. the said Williams  
also agrees that <sup>any</sup> <sup>oil</sup> <sup>and</sup> <sup>gas</sup> <sup>companies</sup> are to have the  
right of way over said lands for the purpose of taking  
off the timber
