interest we hold in the following described tract
or lot of land, namely: all that part of the East
fractional of the South-East quarter of Section
Twenty, Township Twenty six, Range six west
which lies on the South side of the Alabama and
Tennessee River Rail Roads & contiguous to said road
containing ten (10) acres, more or less. We further
covenant with the said Company that we leave
the right to sell & convey said land, and that we
will warrant & defend the said Company in the
peaceable use & possession of the same against the
lawful claims of all persons whosoever.
