

Steele S The State of Alabama<sup>3</sup> This Indenture made and en  
and wife Shelly County<sup>3</sup> entered into this 12<sup>th</sup> day of May 1883  
between Sylvester Steele and wife M. C Steele of the  
first part and Rufus W. Acton of the second part,  
Witnesseth, Whereas the said party of the first part,  
for and in consideration of one hundred dollars  
which auct. is due by note due 1<sup>st</sup> of any 1884 and  
bearing date the day now and in consideration of  
said note above described we bargain sell and con-  
vey and doth by these presents grant bargain sell  
and convey unto said Rufus W. Acton land to his  
heirs and assigns forever, the following described  
tract or parcel of land situated in Shelle County  
and State aforesaid viz, South west 1/4 of South east 1/4  
Section 20 Township 11 Range 2 West. To have and  
to hold to him said party of the second part and  
to his assigns forever. And the party of the first part  
doth not warrant nor do they promise to defend  
the title to the said bargained premises, but only  
convey to the said second party the right title and

interest conveyed to them Aaron Acton & wife which  
title is conveyed by this deed.
