 viz The North half of the South West quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$  of 87 $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and the  
 West half of the South East quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$  of 86 $\frac{3}{4}$ ) of Section twenty  
 Two (22) in Township twenty one (21) South of Range four (4) West.  
 Containing One hundred and fifty acres more or less lying and  
 being in said County and State, To have and to hold onto the said  
 parties of the second part their heirs and assigns forever  
 And the said parties of the first part Covenant with the said par-  
 ties of the second that they are lawfully seized of and have good  
 right to sell and Convey said land and that they will forever  
 warrant and defend the title to the same against the claims
