 party of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowl-
 edged the said parties of the first part have bargained and sold
 and do by these presents grant bargain sell and Convey unto
 the said party of the second part the following described
 real estate lying in the County of Shelley State of Alabama
 to wit Commencing at the South West Corner of that certain
 parcel or lot of land deeded to T J Whalley on the 21st day of
 November 1883 by Helen McBoyle, thence North of East one
 degree 150 feet thence West of North one degree 142 feet, thence
 South of West one degree 150 feet thence East of South 142
 feet to the point of beginning and forming a parallelogram
 of 142 by 150 feet and being in block 8 or 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ in the partic-
 tion of land between the South and North Alabama
 Railroad Company Mrs Kelley and others in Section
 16 T 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ R 2 west To have and to hold to the said party of
 the second part and to his heirs and assigns forever
 and said Thomas J. Whalley and Mary E. Whalley of
 the first part Covenant with the said Stonewall J.
 Jennings of the second part that they are lawfully
 seized in full simple of said premises that they are
 free from all incumbrances except a redemption
 of Wagner Campbell and that they have a good
 right to sell and convey the same that they will
 and their heirs executors and administrators shall
 warrant and defend the same to said Stonewall J.
 Jennings of the second part and his heirs and as-
 signs forever against the lawful claims of all per-
