Richards of the county of Shelby and State of Alabama of the second part Witnesseth that ^{the said} parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars lawful money of the United States of America to them in hand paid by said party of the second part at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have, bargained sold aliened remised released conveyed and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien-

revise release convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs, assigns forever one half interest in the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ and S.W. quarter of Section No 34 in Township No 20 of Range No 4 W. containing one hundred and ninety five acres more or less together with all and singular the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining and the reversion and reversions remainder and remainders rents issues and profits thereof and also all the estate right title interest dower and right of dower property possession claim and demand whatsoever as well in law as in equity of the said parties of the first part of in and to the same and every part and parcel thereof with the appurtenances to have and to hold all and singular the above mention and described premises together with the appurtenances unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever and the said party of the first part and their heirs the said premises in the quiet and peaceable posession of the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns against the said party of the first part their heirs and against all and every person and persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same shall and will warrant and by these presents forever defend.
