 J. D. Hardy entered into this the 21st day
 As of July A.D. 1883 between Jas D. Hardy and
 Elias Lovisa A. Hardy his wife of the Town of Calera
 Williams Shelby County parties of the first part and
 Elias Williams (colored) of town of Calera Shelby
 County parties of the second part: Witnesseth that
 the said party of the first for and in consid-
 eration of the sum of Fifty Dollars to them
 in hand paid by said party of the second part
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged.
 The said party of the first part has bargained
 and sold and do by these presents grant bargain
 sell and convey unto the said party of the sec-
 ond part the following described real estate
 lying in the County of Shelby & state of
 Alabama to wit: That certain lot numbered 10
 one in Black J. Dares plat of Calera lying
 East of L. & N. R. R. the North West corner being
 located at a point on the South line of
 Main Street (33) thirty three feet East from
 the centre of Main track of the G. F. St R. R
 as it now located thence East 30 feet
 on Main Street three South 150 feet thence
 west 30 feet thence North 150 feet to place
 of beginning. To have and to hold to the said
 party of the second part and to his heirs and
 assigns forever. And said J. D. Hardy and
 Lovisa A. Hardy of the first part covenant
 with the said Elias Williams of the second
 part that they are lawfully seized in fee simple
 of said premises that they are free from all
 incumbrances and that have a good right
 to sell and convey the same that they will
 and their heirs executors and administrators shall
 warrant and defend the same to said Elias
 Williams of the second part and his heirs and
 assigns forever against the lawful claims of
