 of the County of Chilton having made complete pay-  
 ment for the North half of section no sixteen in  
 township no twenty four (24) of Range no four-  
 teen (14) East in said County of Chilton and  
 containing three hundred and twenty acres  
 more or less in pursuance of the Act  
 entitled An act to authorize the sale of six-  
 teen sections and for other purposes, approved  
 January 15<sup>th</sup> 1828, There is therefore granted by the  
 State of Alabama the tract of land above described  
 with all the appurtenances thereto belonging unto  
 the said W. H. Shostridge and Mrs C. Shostridge  
 and to their heirs and assigns forever

 to be made Patent and the Great Seal of the  
 State of Alabama to be affixed at the Capital  
 in the City of Montgomery this 13<sup>th</sup> day of
