 forever and said Clement Davis & Martha Davis
 parties of the first part covenant with the said
 Elijah Stinson of the second part that we are lawfully
 seized in fee simple of said premises that they are
 free from all incumbrances and that we have a good
 right to sell and convey the same that we will
 and our heirs executors and administrators shall
 warrant and defend the same to said Elijah Stinson
 of the second part and his heirs and assigns forever
 against the lawful claims of all persons.
