H. D. & wife, January A. D. 1854 between H. H. Nelson, and his wife  
To Ellen E. Nelson, of the state of Alabama & Shelby County  
Synthia I. Williamson of the  
Williamson State and County aforesaid of the 2<sup>d</sup> part, Witnesseth  
that we the said H. H. & Ellen E. Nelson, for and in  
consideration of the sum of Five Hundred and forty  
dollars to us in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby  
fully acknowledged have bargained sold and delivered  
and by these presents do grant bargain sell and deliver  
unto the said Synthia I. Williamson her heirs &c a  
certain tract or piece of land known as the SW<sup>1/4</sup>  
of the SE<sup>1/4</sup> of Sec 3 S 19 R 2 East and all that portion  
of the NE<sup>1/4</sup> of S. 10 S 19 R 2 East that is situated north  
of the road leading from McGraws Mill to William Threaths  
old place on Spring Creek until said road intersects  
or crossed the little creek running up to Daniel Threaths  
thence with the main channel of said little creek until  
it intersects the section line dividing said Sections 3 & 10  
containing One hundred and Seventy acres more or  
less, & situated in the Tuscaloosa Land district.  
To her the said Synthia I. Williamson her heirs executors  
administrators & assigns to have and to hold the above  
land and premises with all the appurtenances thereto  
belonging or in any wise appertaining and we the said  
H. H. & Ellen E. Nelson bind ourselves our heirs & assigns  
to warrant secure and forever defend the right and  
title of the above described land to the said Synthia I.

Williamson her heirs &c against the claim or claims  
of all manner of person or persons, whatsoever claim-  
ing the same under any law in the United States.
