 and do by these presents grant bargain sell  
 and convey unto the said parties of the  
 second part the following described prop-  
 erty real estate lying in the County of Shelby  
 State of Alabama to wit: - E 1/2 of NE 1/4 Sec 11  
 T 20 R 1 West. To have and to hold to the  
 said parties of the second part and to their  
 heirs and assigns forever. And said Henry  
 l. Blaeruby of the first part Covenant with  
 the said Albert l. Messer and Mary Messer  
 of the second part that he is lawfully  
 seized in fee simple of said premises that  
 they are free from all incumbrances and  
 that he has a good right to sell and convey  
 the same that he will and his heirs Executors  
 and administrators shall warrant and  
 defend the same to said A. l. Messer and  
 Mary Messer of the second part and their  
 heirs and assigns forever against the lawful  
 claims of all persons
