 ing described lands lying and being in said  
 state and county viz: South West quarter of South  
 East quarter (SW 1/4 of SE) of section one Township  
 Twenty one Range one East containing Forty acres  
 more or less to have and to hold to unto the  
 party of the second part his heirs and assigns  
 forever the above described premises and the said  
 parties of the first part do hereby bind them-  
 selves their heirs and assigns forever to warrant  
 and defend the title to said land to the said  
 party of the second part his heirs & assigns  
 against the claims of all and every other per-  
 son in law or equity.
