 George J. Harrison of Shelby County State  
 of Alabama for and in consideration of the  
 sum of Three Hundred Dollars in hand  
 paid by the Cahaba Coal Mining Company  
 have granted bargained and sold and by  
 these presents does grant, bargain sell and  
 convey unto said Cahaba Coal Mining Compa-  
 ny the following real estate in Shelby County  
 State of Alabama, to wit:  
 The right of way fifty feet wide on either  
 side of the centerline of the Railroad now  
 being surveyed and as the same may be  
 finally located and constructed over and  
 through the following described lands, The  
 South half of the South West quarter <sup>and</sup> part of  
 the South west quarter of the South East quarter  
 of Section Eight (8) and the North West quarter  
 of Section Seventeen (17) in Township Twenty Two  
 (22) Range Three (3) west it being the intent  
 to grant the right of way over all the grants  
 lands in Shelby County.  
 To have and to hold the same unto the said  
 Cahaba Coal mining Company its suc-  
 cessors and assigns in fee simple forever.  
 And the said Grantor herein hereby covenants  
 to forever warrant and defend the title to said  
 land and does hereby release the said Com-  
 pany off and from all claims to damages

To said land and the crops thereon resulting  
in any manner from the grading construction  
and operation of said Railroad.
