 hand paid the receipt of which is hereby ac-  
 knowledged they have given granted bargained  
 and sold and by these presents do give grant  
 bargain and sell to said Elijah Seale the  
 following described land lying & being in  
 said County Townk: NW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Section 18  
 T 22 R 1 E the NE 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Section 13 T 22 R 1 E  
 or the SE 1/4 of SE 1/4 Section 12 T 22 R 1 E to have  
 and hold the same forever with all the tennants  
 and appurtenances therunto belonging to me  
 the said first part mere forever covenant & de-  
 fend the title to said land to said E. Seale & his  
 heirs forever - witness our hands and seals this  
 day and year above set forth -
