of the first part and Lemuel Balsor of the second part  
witnesseth that the party of the first part for and in con-  
sideration of the sum of one hundred Dollars  
to them in hand paid by the said party of the  
second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
have sold and hereby sell confirm and convey unto  
the said party of the second part the following de-  
scribed land lying in Shelley County State of  
Alabama to wit:

The south west quarter of south east quarter  
of section thirty four Township sixteen of Range  
one west containing forty acres more or less  
- to have and to hold to the second party  
his heirs and assigns forever the above described  
and hereby granted lands and premises.

And the said parties of the first part Husband and wife  
 Hurley covenant with the said party of the second part that  
 we are lawfully seized of and have good right to sell and  
 convey said lands and hereby bind ourselves our heirs  
 and legal representatives forever to warrant and defend  
 the title to said lands and premises to said party of the  
 second part his heirs assigns and legal representatives  
 against the claims of all persons in law and in Eq-  
 uity and against the Government of the United States  
 Given under our hands and seals this day and year  
 above written
