of the SW⁴ of Sec 13 and the East $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NE⁴ of Sec 33 (S³) and the NW⁴ of the NE⁴ of Sec 23 and W² of the SE⁴ of section 14 and the NW⁴ of the SW⁴ of section 24 all in Township 19 Range 7 west except about sixty acres deeded to Moses Johnson by Isaac Johnson deceased
to Rose and to hold the said described lands to the said William M. Allen his heirs and assigns forever together with the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any way affording thereto Williams and Lands and Seals this the 26 day of May AD 1886.
