the construction of the Alabama Mineral Railroad
and further in consideration of the sum of two
hundred dollars in hand paid the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged we do hereby grant bargain
sell transfer and convey unto the Alabama Min-
eral Railroad Co all of the right title and in-
terest of the Reference Church to a strip of land
100 feet in width namely fifty (50) feet on the right
hand and fifty (50) feet on the left of the center line

of its track or Roadway as now or hereafter to be located with such additional width at cuttings and embankments as may be required in and through any portion of the following lot or parcel of land through which said Railroad may pass namely: a tract or parcel of land known as Hopwell Church Lot or property which lies in the same west quarter of same west quarter of Section fifteen (15) Township Sixty two South Range one West (in SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 Sec 15 T 22 R 10W) situated in Shelby County Alabama. The total length of said strip of land being about 210 feet and the entire quantity being estimated at 1/2 acre be the same more or less To Have and to hold the said strip of land in fee simple
