 aforesaid, Witnesseth, that for and in consideration
 of the sum of One Hundred Dollars paid by John
 Farr, we the said Abraham Farr & Redeusia his wife
 have granted, bargained and sold and by these
 presents do grant, bargain, sell and deliver unto the
 said John Farr, his heirs, executors, administrators
 and assigns forever, the following tract or
 parcel of land lying and being in Shelby County
 known as the West half of the South East quar-
 ter of Section four in Township Twenty one of range
 one East in the District of Tuscaloosa, containing
 Eighty acres more or less, Together with all and
 singular the rights, privileges appurtenances and
 hereditaments thereto belonging or in any wise
 appertaining to the same to have and to hold all and
 singular the ~~rights~~ ^{premises} ~~before~~ mentioned unto the
 said John Farr his heirs and assigns forever and
 we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs, executors or
 administrators to warrant and forever to defend
 all and singular the above described tract or par-
 cel of land and premises unto John Farr his heirs
 and assigns and against ourselves our heirs and
 assigns and against every other person whom-
 soever lawfully claiming or to claim the same
 or any part thereof, in testimony whereof we have
 hereunto set our names and affixed our seals this
 January 29th day A.D. 1849. Abraham ^{his} Farr (Seal)
