To know all men by these presents that in consider-
ation of the sum of Twenty five Dollars to me
in hand paid by John A. Griffie the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged I do severally
release, quit claim & convey to the said Jno. A.
Griffie all my right, title, interest & claim in
unto the following described land, (viz) all of
that part of W¹/S of N¹/W¹ that lies on the East side
of Beaver Dam Creek except the part deeded to David
Meredith by Jno. W. Naish containing Twenty acres
more or less & a part of the E¹/S of the N¹/W¹ con-
taining Thirty acres more or less, except that
portion of the above described two pieces or frac-
tions of land that lies South of a conditional
line made & agreed to heretofore between Jno. A.
Griffie & myself, to be described as follows:
To commence at a certain rock placed on the East
Bank of Beaver Dam Creek & situated about
20 feet North of a Large Elm Tree, and to run
from this point in a direct line a little South
of East to another rock placed in the Ground
about Twenty feet East of the corner of the said
Jno. A. Griffie & Jno. M. Lacey's field and to run
from this point in angle South East to a large
Pine Tree or ~~stone~~ thus on West side, (x) also

a rock placed at the root of the same tree on west side, this tree being situated near the west line & near south west corner of the piece of land known as the Sausage Piece also the $\frac{3}{4}$ of the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$, all in Sec. 9, T. 21, Range 3 west - John M.
