Shelby County } The Sheriff of Shelby County, State of  
Alabama, under and by virtue of several certain  
executions issued out of the Circuit Court of Shelby  
County aforesaid on judgments against J. D. Hardy  
said the following real estate of as the property  
of said J. D. Hardy, to wit: One (1) vacant lot of land  
100 feet front on Smith Street by a depth of one hun-  
dred and eighty (80) feet on West side of the L. & N. R. R.  
and north of Freeman and Mason's Base Line, at  
the intersection of same; also five (5) acres of land

lying near New Town Spring the same being the five acres of land heretofore sold and conveyed by C. C. Oliver and wife to J. D. Hardy together with the four buildings situate on said five acres of land and adjoining the "Park" (so called) also one (1) lot of land extending from the L. & N. R. R. to Montgomery Avenue and bounded on the South by Adams Street and a large ditch, on the north by property of R. E. O'Brien containing two and one half (2 1/2) acres of land, all being and lying in the Town of Calera, County of Shelby and State of Alabama; now know all men by these presents that for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Louisa A. Hardy the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, I do bargain, sell and convey unto the said Louisa A. Hardy all rights and equities of redemption I may have in and to all and singular the above described real estate. Herby intending to convey to said Louisa A. Hardy all rights and equities I may have either in law or equity of redemption in and to said lands or any part thereof. To have and to hold to the said Louisa A. Hardy her heirs and assigns forever.
