


Nalee, The State of Alabama, Shelby County.
 Martha A. Nalee all men by these presents, That for and in
 consideration of One Hundred & Twenty Dollars to the
H.C. & M.B. undersigned grantor, Martha A. Nalee in hand paid
 by H.C. & M.B. Reynolds the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged I do grant, bargain, sell and convey
 unto the said H.C. & M.B. Reynolds, an undivided half
 interest in and to the following described real estate
 to wit: Eight (8) acres lying in the North west corner
 of the $\frac{1}{4}$ of $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 17, T 24 R 12 E. said eight
 acres to lie as follows, commence at the North west
 corner of said $\frac{1}{4}$ of $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 17 and run due east for
 a distance of four acres or 840 feet then South for
 a distance of two acres or 420 feet then West for
 a distance of four acres or 840 feet then North dis-
 tance of two acres or 420 feet to place of beginning
 Said land being more fully described by diagram
 below -

It is agreed that the streets running through said land

are to conform to streets now laid off in Town of Brad dock and quantity of land conveyed by this deed is to be exclusive of streets now or hereafter to be laid off in said Town, through said land, situated in Shelby County, Alabama - To have and to hold to the said H. E. & W.B. Reynolds their heirs and assigns forever. And I do for my heirs, executors and administrators, covenant with said H. E. & W.B. Reynolds their heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee simple of said premises; that they are free from all encumbrances, and that I have a good right to sell and convey the same as aforesaid; that I will and my heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said H. E. & W.B. Reynolds, their heirs, executors and assigns forever, against the lawful claims of all persons. The party conveying this land agreed to give Reynolds the refusal of his interest in above eight acres of land before selling to anyone - Given under my hand and seal this 15 day of Sept. 1891.
