No. 34636 Whereas James Brasher of Shelby County Alabama
has deposited in the General Land Office of the United
States a certificate of the register of the land office at
Tuscaloosa whereby it appears that full payment has been
made by said by the said James Brasher according
to the provisions of the acts of Congress of the 24th day of
April 1830 in "An act making further provision for
the sale of the public lands;" for the North East $\frac{1}{4}$
of the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section Seven in Township Ninety
of Range one west in the district of Lands
subject to sale at Tuscaloosa Alabama containing
 $39 \frac{1}{4}$ acres according to the official plat of the Survey of
said lands returned to the General Land Office by the
Surveyor General which said tract has been
purchased by the said James Brasher

I now know you that the United States of America
in consideration of the premises and in conformity
with the several acts of Congress in such cases made
and provided Land given and granted and by
these presents do give and grant unto the said
James Brasher and to his heirs the said tract above
and assigns the said tract above described
to have and to hold the same together with all
the rights privileges immunities and appurtenances
of whatsoever nature belonging unto the
said James Brasher and to his heirs and es-
cuses forever. In testimony whereof I James
Buchanan President of the United States of America
have caused this instrument to be made patent and the
Seal of the General Land Office to be affixed thereto

thousand eight hundred and fifty eight and the
