& her husband John G. Wilson, Nancy Harrington &
her husband J. D. Harrington Sallie E. Wilson & her
husband Robert C. Wilson & William J. Moore parties
of the first part (the said John G. Wilson & D. Harring-
ton & Robert C. Wilson hereby containing consenting
for their said wives respectively to enter into
this contract & forming in this deed for the further
purposes of enabling their said wives respectively to
convey their separate estate as well as to convey
all their right title interest & estate in & to the
following described & herein enclosed easement
& privilege) & Rebecca G. Norton parties of the second
part witnesseth That whereas the said John G. Wilson
& Robert C. Wilson did on the 23 day of November
as the owner authorized & legally appointed attorney
in fact for the heirs of J. H. Moore deceased make &
executed to Mrs. M. W. Jones a certificate of purchase
of certain lands belonging to the estate of said
J. H. Moore deceased together with the privilege &
easements herinafter conveyed & did bind themselves
& heirs of said J. H. Moore deceased to make little
to the said Mrs. M. W. Jones his heirs or assigns upon
her compliance with the terms of said sale & whereas
the said Mrs. M. W. Jones assigned said certificate
& bond to said party of the second part who has
fully complied with the terms thereof & whereas
said parties of the first part have hitherto waited
on the 9 day of April 1891, conveyed the lands pur-
chased at said sale to said party of the second
part but inadvertently omitted from said deed the
easement & privilege herein contained & therein
intended to be conveyed for therefore in consider-
ation of the premises & of the sum of one dollar in
hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
said parties of the first part as the heirs of J. H. Moore
deceased have granted bargained sold & conveyed
& do by these presents grant bargain sell & convey
into said party of the second part the following
described privilege & easement hovit the right of
free use of the water in the most northerly spring
on the forty two acres more or less pur-
chased by Louisa Troxell at said sale of
lands belonging to said wife of J. H. Moore
and made by said John G. & Robert C. Wilson
as attorney in fact as aforesaid and the

right of grows & herbage to and from said
Spring both on foot and by horse for family
and stock uses
to have and to hold unto said party of the
second host his heirs and assigns
forever. And said parties of the first host
covenant with said party of the second host
that they are lawfully seized of said prop-
erties and easements that they have a good right
to sell and convey the same and that they
will forever warrant and defend the title to the
same to said party of the second host against
the claims of any and all persons whomsoever either
