Church South the following described real estate to wit that lot or parcel of land commencing at a point 100 feet south west of the south west corner of that certain building known as New Salem Church & running thence 210 feet east thence 420 ft north thence 210 ft west & thence 420 ft south to point of beginning said parcel or lot of land being laid off for & to contain two acres of land lying between parallel lines upon which said lot or parcel of land are now situated said New Salem Church & the grave yard known as the Calera Cemetery all lying & being in quarters of section 12 Township 22 R. 2 west containing county of Shelby & State of Alabama together with all & singular the right, privileges & performances thence belonging to have & to hold the premises hereby conveyed unto the said M. E. Church South in trust that said premises shall be used kept & maintained & disposed of as a place of divine worship for the use of the ministry & membership of the M. E.
