

according to the plat of the town of Aldrich said
lot being of following dimensions commencing at
the South west corner of a lot sold to Perry which

is 25 x 100 & run north (200) two hundred feet & then east one hundred & forty two & a half (142 1/2) feet & then south two hundred & twenty five feet & then west forty two & a half feet (42 1/2) to the corner of the Perry lot it being the entire west half of said lot 23 excepting the lot heretofore sold to Perry being further described as the diagram below

We have & to hold the said H C & W B Reynolds their heirs & assigns forever & We do for our heirs executors & administrators covenant with said H C & W B Reynolds heirs & assigns that we are lawfully seized in fee simple of said premises that they are free from all incumbrances & that we have a good right to sell & convey the same as aforesaid that we will & our heirs executors & administrators shall warrant & defend the same to the said H C & W B Reynolds heirs executors & assigns forever against the lawful claims of all persons Given under our hands & seals this 30 day of March 1892
