

estate to wit the North half of the S E $\frac{1}{4}$ of S W $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 28 T 21
Ranger 4 west containing 20 acres it being the same
land in which I have heretofore sold said said
Reynolds a half interest situated in Shelby County
Alabama I also agree in case I sell or
offer for sale the remaining portion of my land
situated in Sections 33 & 28 to give said Reynolds the
two fifths of the same I do for my heirs
and executors covenant with said C C & W B Reynolds
that I am lawfully bound in fee simple of
said lands and hereby warrant the title to
the same
