 Shelby State of Alabama to wit all that part of the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of
 SW. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36 Th 21 Range 1 west that lies east of the
 public road leading from Columbiana to McTumpka known as
 the McTumpka or Montgomery road also 19 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres off
 of the west side of the SW. $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE. $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 36 Th 21
 Range 1 west containing in all 40 acres more or less
 to have and to hold to the said party of the second part
 and to his heirs and assigns forever, and said
 Margaret J. Brasher party of the first part concur with
 the said Jack Wallace party of the second part that I
 give freely sign in fee simple of said premises
 that they are free from all encumbrances and that I have
 a full right to sell and convey the same that I
 will and my heirs executors and administrators shall
 prosecute and defend the same to said Jack Wallace
 party of the second part and his heirs and assigns forever
 against the several claims of all persons
