



Hale State of Alabama (Know all men by these presents that we

partners doing business under the firm name of Morris & D'Bardeleben Lumber Company at right of way for a railroad thirty five feet wide on each side of the center of the line as now located over and through the following described land to wit: Commencing at Station 22+15 and extending to Station 39+50 N.W. of S8 $\frac{1}{4}$ & S $\frac{3}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 7 Th 21 R 2 west lying and being in Shelby County Ala together with such rights of way over may roads and track roads as may hereafter be selected and located by said John E Morris and Henry F D'Bardeleben partners doing business under the firm name of Morris & D'Bardeleben Lumber Company over and through the following described lands to wit: West half of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and that part of the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ part of oak ridge all in Section 7 Th 21 Range 2 west situated in Shelby County Ala To have and to hold unto the said John E Morris and Henry F D'Bardeleben partners doing business under the firm name of Morris & D'Bardeleben Lumber Company their heirs and assigns forever.
