Railroad over and through the following described lands to wit commencing at Station 150 and extending to Station 19 $\frac{1}{2}$  + 70 being a part of 18 $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec 4 and the rest of N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec 3 all in the 21 R + 21 W section in Shelby County Alabama. But it is agreed that all timber cut on or near the said right of way is hereby reserved to the use of the said John E Roach together with such rights of way as may hereafter be selected and located by said John E Roach Morris and Henry F D'Bardeleben partners doing business under the firm name of Morris & D'Bardeleben Lumber Company for wagon roads or tram ways or over and through the following described lands to wit N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec 4 and N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$  of N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 3 all in T. 21 R. 21 W except lands in cultivation and situated in Shelby County Alabama also the right to cut any large trees near said rail road that may by falling run or shading said rail road injure the same to said and to hold to the said John E Morris and Henry F D'Bardeleben partners doing business in the firm name of Morris and D'Bardeleben Lumber Company their heirs and assigns forever.
