 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath bargained and
 sold and conveyed to the said Thomas Collier and
 Saecr Collier his wife the following described land
 to wit commencing at the corner of the SW 1/4 of the SE 1/4
 of Section 17 of T 22 R 22 of Range 7 or running to a hollow or
 place most thence to the Shirley Springs Road thence
 run the said Road to the corner the Shirley post
 making said land in the shape of a V the said
 land has double log house on it and contains
 3 acres more or less 90 feet wide to hold the
 afore granted premises their use and behoof and
 that we the said John M Leach and Et A Leach
 have a good right to sell and convey to the said
 & Saecr Collier this his and assigns and that we
 John M Leach & Et A Leach our heirs and administrators
 will warrant and defend the titles to the said Thomas
 & Saecr Collier this his and assigns against our heirs
 and assigns against the law claims of
 all persons In witness whereof we have here
 unto set our hands and doves affixed our seals this the
