consideration of the sum of Four hundred
and Fifty dollars to us paid the said Grantor have
bargained and sold and by these presents do by mutual conveyance
and convey unto said Grantees certain real estate property
in said County and State described as follows A post
of E 1/2 of N.W 1/4 and of W 1/2 of N.E 1/4 of Sec 26 Township 21 Range 1
West North of Town Branch and North of what was known
formerly as the Remond's Iron Ford sat and south of dirt
road running from Columbiana to Tuscaloosa also
a small lot or parcel of land on the west and south
side of said branch described as a large bend containing
as supposed in the bend of said branch. Three four or
More acres. Supposed to be a post up the west bank of said
North east quarter and of Sec 26 T 21 R 1 W also all of the
E 1/2 of said N.E 1/4 of Sec 26 T 21 R 1 W sat that lies north
of a line running east and west of the right of way
of the Shelby Iron Company's RR containing in all Fifty
Eight acres. More or less except eight acres sold to
